



What you will need:

Any hook you want. Match it to your yarn. I used 2.5mm hook and cotton yarn.

Abbreviations:

SC = single crochet

DC=Double crochet

Sl St = slip stitch

ch 5, sl st to make a round.

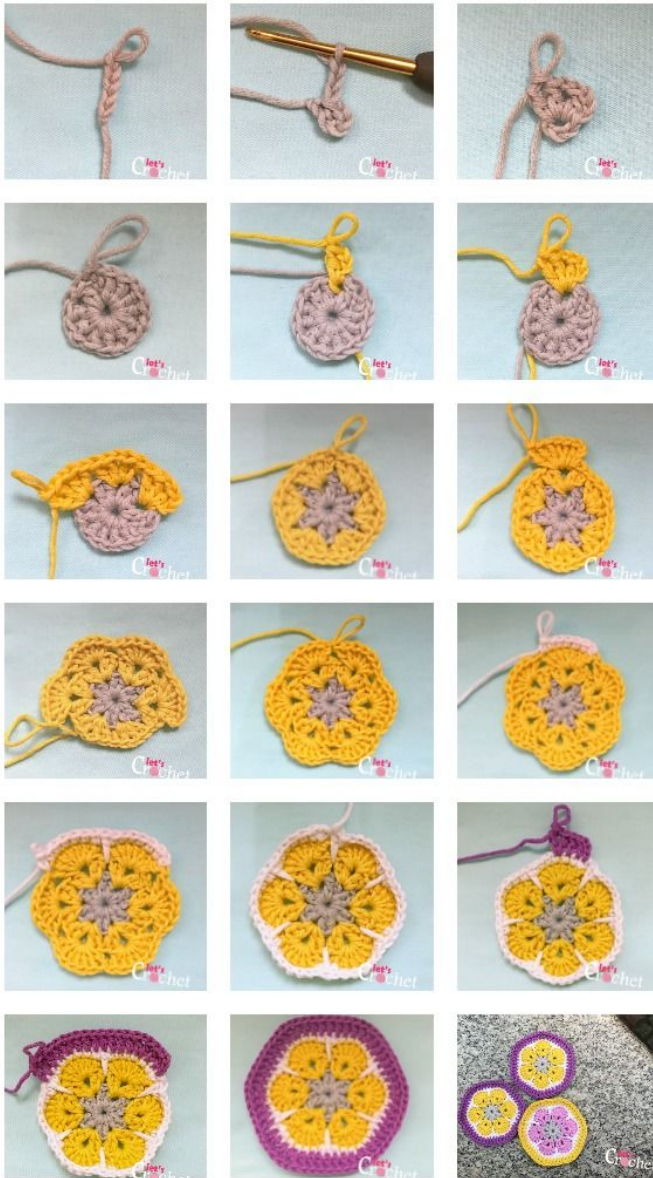
Rd 1: Chain 3, 1 DC in the loop, chain 1, * 2 DC in the loop, chain 1 *, repeat *-* 5 times. Sl St into the third chain. Fasten off.

Rd 2: Insert hook any chain 1 space. Yarn around hook, pull yarn through. chain 3, 1 DC in the same chain space, chain 1, 2 DC. * 2 DC, chain 1, 2 DC in next chain 1 space *. repeat *-* 5 times. Sl St into the third chain.

Rd 3: Sl St in next 2 stitches. Chain 3, 6 DC in chain 1 space. 7 DC in next 5 chain 1 space. Sl St into the third chain. Fasten off.

Rd 4: Change yarn. Chain 1, * 1 SC around and make a long stitch down in round 2 between flower petal *. repeat *-* 6 times. Sl St and fasten off.

Rd 5: Change yarn. Chain 3, 1 DC in next 2 stitch, * (1 DC, Chain 1, 1 DC) in next same stitch. 1 DC in next 7 stitch *. repeat 5 times. (1 DC, Chain 1, 1 DC) in next same stitch, 1 DC in next 4 stitch. Sl St and fasten off.
