

What you will need:

- medium weight yarn
- 3 mm crochet hook
- Toy polyester stuffing
- yarn needle
- Stitch Markers
- Scissor

Abbreviations:

SC = single crochet

DC = Double Crochet

SI St = Slip Stitch

Paw: (make 2)

Rd 1: Pull the magic ring off you fingers and you have an adjustable ring! Then chain 3, 11 DC into the ring, and tighten your ring, all you have to do is pull the tail yarn tightly. Then join to the first DC with a SI St. **(12 sts)**

Rd 2: Chain 3, 1 DC in same stitch, 2 DC in next every stitches. Then join to the first DC with a SI St. **(24 sts)**

Rd 3: Chain 3, 1 DC in same stitch, 2 DC in next every stitches. Then join to the first DC with a SI St. **(48 sts)**

Rd 4: * skip 2 stitches, 7 DC in next stitch, Skip 2 stitches, SC in next 2 stitches *, Repeat *-* 2 times, skip 2 stitches, 7 DC in next stitch, Skip 2 stitches then SI St.

Rd 5: Chain 1, then work on the other side. 2 SC in first 6 stitches, 1 SC in next stitch, skip 2 stitches, 1 SC in next stitch. 2 SC in next 5 stitches, 1 SC in next stitch, skip 2 stitches, 1 SC in next stitch. 2 SC in next 6 stitches, end of SI St. Chain 1, leave long tails to sew up with and fasten off.



Paw pads: (Small *3)

Rd 1: Chain 1, 6 SC in magic ring. Then join to the first SC with a SI St. (6 sts)

Rd 2: Chain 1, 1 SC in same stitch, 2 SC in next every stitches. Then join to the first SC with a SI St. Cut yarn and fasten off. **(12 sts)**


Paw pads: (Big *1)

Rd 1: Chain 1, 6 SC in magic ring. Then join to the first SC with a SI St. (6 sts)

Rd 2: Chain 1, 2 SC in every stitches. Then join to the first SC with a SI St. (12 sts)

Rd 3: Chain 1, * 1 SC in first stitch, 2 SC in next stitch *. Repeat *-* 6 times, Then join to the first SC with a SI St. (18 sts)

Rd 4: Chain 1, * 1 SC in first 2 stitches, 2 SC in next stitch *. Repeat *-* 6 times, Then join to the first SC with a SI St. Cut yarn and fasten off. **(24 sts)**



Sew these parts together as shown. Be sure to leave a small opening to lightly stuff with polyester before you completely sew it.
